Deconstructing Constructed Response

Open response and constructed response are not the same! Do you know the difference? Old methods used to teach students how to answer open response questions are outdated and will not satisfy new requirements under Senate Bill One. This session focuses on constructed response questions and how they compare and contrast with open response. Participants will learn how to write good constructed response questions and how to teach students to write exemplary constructed response answers.
